!!HOT TIP!!

Speak the Civilian Lingo!

When interviewing for a position in the public sector, avoid using military jargon. What makes sense to you in military terms, may not be evident to someone outside of the armed forces. Either on your resume or during the interview process, using terms and speech that are unknown to hiring managers can significantly hinder your chances of being considered for the position.

Example: Instead of saying Battalion, say organization or agency instead. Something as small as this can make the difference!
